What do we look for?

These opportunities are for trainees and therefore do not require you to have any experience in your chosen profession. What we do require is:

- Minimum of 5 National 5's (must include English and Maths), and 2 Highers, useful subjects are Maths, English, Physics (This is due to college entry requirements for the HNC element of the course)
- An understanding of your chosen profession
- An understanding of the importance of Health and Safety
- An understanding of the benefits of effective teamwork and customer care principles
- A willingness to learn and adapt to the working and college environment

This vacancy is restricted to applicants who have recently attended a South Lanarkshire Council School and/or live in the South Lanarkshire Area. You must be 16 years of age by 27/09/2019 and must be no older than 24 years of age by 09/08/2019. Or if you are disabled or care experienced, and aged between 20 to 29 years of age by 09/08/2019, you may be eligible to apply if you meet the rest of the criteria as South Lanarkshire Council and Skills Development Scotland recognise that disabled people and those who are care experienced can face challenges on their career journey.
